GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

1. **In the event of rain**, the event will take place on Saturday, May 11, 2024. Since "**No Refunds**" will be given, please plan on being available on both dates.
2. Parade applications will be reviewed and categorized by the Parade Chairman.
3. **All vehicles must carry proof of vehicle insurance.**
4. Registration table will be located at Fifth Street & Merrill Street from 7:30 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
5. Parade entry number and directions to your staging location will be provided during registration. Place your entry number on the right-hand side of your lead vehicle or entry.
6. Parade will start promptly at 10:00 a.m.
7. Adults are responsible for all children riding or walking along the parade route.
8. Please follow the directions of the volunteers.
9. Decorations must be non-combustible or flame retardant.
10. Please provide your own signage or identification banner.
11. **You are not allowed to "throw" candy or anything else along the parade route.** Police Officers will pull violators off the parade line-up.
12. **No "Silly String"** is allowed along the parade route.
13. Motorized parade floats and towing apparatus shall provide a minimum 2-A, 10-BC rated portable fire extinguisher readily available to the driver.
14. **Car Club limit** – a maximum of six (6) vehicles per club. **No three wheel motion allowed.**
15. There will be three (3) announcers along the parade route to introduce your entry. First location - Corona Mall, 2nd location - Mejia TV, and 3rd location - Corona Chamber of Commerce.
16. **Judging** will be at the 2nd location (**Mejia TV - 510 E. Sixth Street**).
17. Parade will end at approximately at 11:00 a.m.
